

## **POSTDOCTORAL (POST-DOC) POSITION IN TRANSLATIONAL PSYCHIATRY UNIT**

We invite applications for a postgraduate position in the Translational Psychiatry Unit at the Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy (Head: Prof. Stefan Borgwardt), Centre of Integrative Psychiatry and University of Lübeck.

We are looking for a highly motivated and scientifically skilled post-doc to conduct translational clinical research of precision psychiatry, neuropsychiatric disorders, brain-gut interactions and mental effects of psychotropic substances. This position is embedded in the clinical research environment where she/he will be working in an interdisciplinary team of neuroscientists, psychiatrists, psychologists, biologists and physicists.

For the postgraduate position candidates should have a relevant degree in biology, psychology, neuroscience, IT or in a related field. Furthermore, they should be familiar with neuroimaging/EEG methods or computational psychiatry methods and have a strong translational interest in clinical research and applications. IT and programming skills (i.e. Matlab, SPM/FSL) are highly advantageous.

The position is available for at least 3 years and potentially permanent.
